



NATURIST LEGACY GENERAL STANDARDS AND POLICIES

SPECIAL NOTE: Naturist Legacy Park is very new and still under construction. This document references various amenities that may not be available yet (the pool and hot tub, for instance).

OUR VALUES

Naturism (also called nudism) is the practice of going without clothing in social settings (generally in mixed-gender groups of all ages) in the belief that doing so is beneficial. Naturist Legacy believes in and supports the principle of providing a safe and secure environment where naturism suitable for all ages can be legally practiced in a natural and non-sexual setting. We are committed to providing a family-friendly naturist environment that is wholly appropriate for all persons regardless of age, race, gender, relationship status, religion, physical ability or appearance.

STANDARDS

We are not only a naturist park, but also a community. The following standards and policies reflect the "personality" of this community and allow us all the freedom to enjoy this place in a safe and non-threatening manner. Common sense, respect for others and good manners should apply in all circumstances.

We encourage everyone to speak up for our standards. If you see a person who seems unaware of these standards, please explain them -- kindly and plainly.

These standards and policies will be strictly enforced. Failure to abide by them will have consequences ranging from warnings to monetary fines to membership termination.

Conduct that endangers the safety or security of members, their children or their guests, or that betrays their privacy and confidentiality as nudists, or that damages the reputation of Naturist Legacy Inc. or Naturist Legacy Park, will result in immediate expulsion from our membership and exclusion from our premises. No refunds of any kind will be paid to anyone expelled with cause from Naturist Legacy Inc. or Naturist Legacy Park.

GENERAL CONDUCT

Naturist Legacy Inc. operates a family-oriented naturist park where everyone is expected to conduct themselves accordingly. Violence, overt sexual behaviour, vulgar language, criminal conduct, intoxication, use of illegal substances and inappropriate conduct with children are not permitted. Sexual "swinging" and solicitation is prohibited. Physical or verbal activity that is abusive, harassing or disruptive to others is not permitted. Gawking is impolite. It's okay to look but always rude to stare.

DRESS CODE

It's assumed that you come here because you want to be a part of the nudist experience. Our general rule is, "Nude when possible, clothed when practical." Members and visitors are expected to be nude except when clothing is required for common sense reasons such as for medical or health issues, sun protection, cool temperatures or physical protection while working. On certain days, women may wear shorts or a similar cover up. Lingerie, underwear or sexually-provocative clothing is never appropriate here. Clothing is never allowed in the pool or hot tub.

We permit newcomers time to become acclimated. If a family member (a spouse or a child) chooses to visit without full participation, clothing may be accepted for the sake of that family within limits.

TOWELS

Always sit or lie on a towel while nude. It's suggested that you carry a towel with you at all times and that you bring two towels to the pool area -- one to sit or lie on and the other to dry off with after showering or using the pool or hot tub.

PRIVACY

Respect the privacy of others. The use of first names only is acceptable and widely practiced among nudists. Avoid personal questions and remember that it's always a person's own choice whether to divulge personal information. It's good to be friendly, but some people would prefer not to be disturbed. Take your cues from their response and body language. Never reveal the names of nudists to outsiders.

BODY CONTACT

Body contact is limited to simple expressions of affection and friendship. Intimate contact, suggestive behavior, overt sexuality or sexually provocative behavior are not permitted.

HEALTH

Persons with open sores or communicable diseases may not use the pool or hot tub.

LANGUAGE

There are sensitive ears of all ages present. Please watch your language. Coarse, profane, obscene, vulgar, abusive or sexually suggestive language will not be tolerated.

BODY DECORATION

Body decorations, piercings and tattoos must not conflict with our family atmosphere. They shall be tasteful, conservative and non-ostentatious. Jewelry displayed for a sexual purpose or to bring undue attention to the genital area is prohibited. Management reserves the right to determine what is appropriate.

PHOTOGRAPHY

In order to preserve everyone's privacy, absolutely no cameras are allowed. Cell phones (most of which have picture-taking abilities) should be left in vehicles, bags or trailers and used only when well away from the population. If any member or visitor suspects that a person is taking unauthorized pictures, the device must be surrendered immediately to management and all content inspected.

Photos may be taken **ONLY** by park-approved photographers, and then only with the permission of those being photographed.

SMOKING

Smokers agree to smoke only in designated areas. Always be considerate of non-smokers and take care to avoid persons who are sensitive to smoke. Due to fire risk, smoking is not allowed on hiking trails or elsewhere within our forested grounds.

ALCOHOL

Alcoholic beverages are permitted in moderation. Offensive, obnoxious and antisocial behavior caused by inebriation is prohibited and never tolerated. If a person can't handle their drinking, then they shouldn't drink.

DRUGS

No illegal substance may be brought to Naturist Legacy Park. Management will report to and cooperate with all authorities if illegal substances are found anywhere on our grounds.

PETS

Pets must be secured at all times and on a leash when in public areas. All areas used by your pet must be kept clean at all times.

NOISE

Electronic devices like radios, televisions, CD and MP3 players may be used provided the volume is kept low so that others aren't disturbed. Ear buds or headphones are suggested in common areas.

Quiet time is between the hours of 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. and will be strictly enforced. Do not allow the volume of your electronic devices to disturb your neighbors. Avoid excessively loud conversation.

CHILDREN

Children are our most cherished guests. For their safety and everyone else's comfort, parents must keep their children under their direct supervision at all times. Parents will be accountable for the actions of their children.

Adults should NEVER approach or play with unfamiliar children.

TRASH

Hauling garbage to the dump is very expensive. If you're a member, please take your trash home with you. Visiting non-members should place their trash in designated receptacles. Please recycle whenever possible!

NATURAL SURROUNDINGS

Your safety within the natural surroundings of Naturist Legacy Park is your responsibility (please see the liability section below). While nature offers much beauty here, it also presents hazards: unsafe surfaces, holes in the ground, fallen trees, etc. Please be careful. A wide variety of plants and animals are found here, some of which may be dangerous. Learn to identify and avoid poison ivy, poison oak and other noxious plants. Never ingest the berries or fruit of an unknown plant. Animals that you encounter should be considered wild and potentially dangerous.

Please help us to maintain our grounds in their pristine condition. Do not cut or trim trees without permission from management. Do not put nails, staples, screws, hooks, etc. into the trees.

SPEED LIMIT

Vehicles must not exceed 10 km/h within Naturist Legacy Park. ATV's and motorized dirt bikes must not be operated on our grounds except to arrive and leave. Use is restricted to main roads. Engines must remain at idle and riders must not exceed our 10 km/h speed limit.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Anything that endangers your safety or that of others is prohibited. Illegal substances, fireworks, firearms and other weapons are forbidden on our grounds. No glass is allowed except on seasonal lots.

CAMPFIRES

Fires are allowed in management-approved enclosed (screened) fireplaces only. Always keep a bucket of water close to your fire. Do not cut trees on the grounds for firewood (it will be provided). All fires must be extinguished when left unattended. Be extremely cautious during dry conditions. Obey all fire safety rules.

LIABILITY

Members and guests will be held personally liable for any damage to Naturist Legacy Park property resulting from their actions. Naturist Legacy Inc. assumes no responsibility for personal property brought onto or left on its premises. Members and guests use our grounds and facilities at their own risk. Your use of our grounds represents your agreement that you will not hold Naturist Legacy Inc., its directors, its officers or its members liable for any harm, injury, loss, inconvenience or damage that you, your children or your guests may suffer or sustain while on our property.
