



## NATURIST LEGACY PARK NUDIST ETIQUETTE FOR VISITORS

In general, the same common-sense guidelines for behaviour apply in the nudist world as in the clothed world. Be polite and respect the rights of others.

- Gawking is impolite. It's okay to look but always rude to stare.
- For sanitary reasons, always sit on a towel.
- Don't stray into areas that can be seen by the public. Nudists are not trying to offend anyone.
- Abide by all posted rules.
- Don't engage in overt sexual activity — ever.
- Respect the privacy and "space" of others. It's good to be friendly, but take your cues from the responses and body language of people you meet.
- Smokers agree not to smoke within 9 metres (30 feet) of common areas (defined as the washrooms, showers, fenced pool area, clubhouse, volleyball and bocce courts). Always be considerate of non-smokers.
- Alcoholic beverages are permitted in moderation.
- If you bring your smart phone or other photo-capable devices with you, please be aware that photography is highly restricted at the park.
- Children are the sole responsibility of their parents and must be under their direct supervision **at all times**.
- Respect the property of others.
- If you don't know about something, ask someone who does. Don't "assume." Never engage in any behaviour that will require an apology.
- Speak to management if anyone does anything that makes you feel uncomfortable.
